2. GST: Shall be payable extra as applicable. The present applicable rate of GST is @ 12%. Input tax credit on GST shall be availed by WCL as per GST rule. You shall submit GST compliant invoice enabling WCL to avail Input Tax Credit (ITC) under GST. In case of any failure on supplier's account, the penalty including interest (if any) borne by WCL on ITC shall be recovered from supplier..

3. Delivery: A quantity of 25 % of the ordered quantity should be supplied within 90 days from the date of order. These will be subjected to laboratory test and practical performance test as per the Clause-B of the DGMS(Tech.) Circular no. 8 dated 27.10.2008 as well as DGMS(Tech.) Circular no. 8 dated 28.09.2015. These will be deployed in mines for a year during which firm will have to comply with tests under clause A of DGMS(Tech.) Circular no. 8 dated 27.10.2008. Testing of this supplied quantity will be tested as per clause 2.0 of DGMS(Tech.) Circular no. 8 dated 27.10.2008 after one year of putting into use. Subject to satisfactory performance of supplied 25% quantity, clearance will be given for supply of remaining quantity .

Balance 75% of the order quantity shall be commence within 4 months and completed within 6 months from the date of issue of clearance to supply. However this balance quantity is subject to review after assessment of actual requirement by GM(Rescue)HOD.



After one year the firm has to submit the PBG for 15% of the value of the 1st phase supply valid for a period of 9 years and 6 months.

b. For remaining quantity (75% quantity to be supplied in 2 nd phase), 80% Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of receipt of satisfactory laboratory test report and practical performance test report as per Clause-B of DGMS(Tech.) 7. Inspection : Inspection of the consignment shall be carried out at the consignee stores by the authorized representative of GM(Rescue) MRS, Nagpur.

8. Inspecting / Performance certifying authority: For the purpose of inspection and acceptance of the materials supplied, for certifying the satisfactory practical performance test reports, for confirmation of Satisfactory Performance in case of Performance Bank Guarantee, for claiming of any Warranty Claims and for performance monitoring of the equipment during the Service Life , GM(Rescue), MRS, Nagpur shall be the Nodal Authority.

In case the successful tenderer fails to deposit the security money, the order shall be cancelled and the case shall be processed to order elsewhere and the firm's performance is to be kept recorded for future dealings with them.


Security deposit money will be refunded to the firm within 30 days from the date of satisfactory execution of the contract. For unsatisfactory performance and / or contractual failure, the security money shall be forfeited.

Security Money may be converted into performance bank guarantee (PBG) (wherever PBG is required as per the contract). However, in such case the amount of PBG should not be less than 10% (ten percent) of the landed value of the order.

10 Performance Bank Guarantee For 1st phase supply (25% of the order quantity), the firm has to submit PBG for 100% of the landed value of the materials supplied, which shall be valid for a period of 15 months from the date of supply.

After 1 years of supply of the 1st phase supply and after ascertainment of the performance of the 1st phase supply, the firm shall submit the PBG for 15% of the landed value of the materials supplied in 1st phase, which shall be valid for a period of 9 years and 6 months. After submission and acceptance of this PBG, the initial PBG for 100% value shall be released.





For 2nd phase supply (75% of the order quantity) the firm has to submit PBG for 15% landed value of the material supplied(each supply) which shall be valid for a period of 10 years 6 months from the date of supply along with the supplies, which may be extended if required.

PBG shall be released or en-cashed in part or full on the basis of the performance of the contract.

In case the Bankers do not provide the validity at a stretch, then the bidder will be required to give/ upload an undertaking /affidavit on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100 value that they will get the validity of the PBG extended from time to time well in advance (three months) to cover the entire service Life period of 10 years and also that for the failure of the supplier to extend the PBG at least one month before its expiry, WCL will have the right to encash the same. The PBG shall be released after satisfactory completion of the Service Life of the Product as per the contract

11.GUARANTEE/WARRANTY: Firm shall undertake the guarantee of SCSR for Service Life of 10 years (Ten years) (as indicated in clause 13 and also in Annexure I) from the date of receipt and acceptance after sampling & testing as per Clause B of DGMS (Tech.) Circular no.08 of 2008, 8A dated 18.12.08 and 8 dated 28.09.2015.

If SCSR fails within Guarantee / Warranty period, from the date of acceptance, firm shall replace free of cost the SCSR within two months (As indicated clause 14 and also in Annexure I technical specification) or in case of failure to do so, WCL will have the right to recover the cost.

In case, the amount to be recovered falls short from PBG amount, the firm will have to pay the balance amount and in case of failure of the bidder to refund the amount, WCL reserves the right to recover it from the pending bills and other dues in WCL/other subsidiaries of CIL

12. Sampling and Testing :-

(a) Before a batch of SCSR is put into service, 3% samples, subject to minimum 12 units, for every batch of supply shall be drawn at random for testing by joint sampling team comprising of representative from manufacturer /supplier and users at the user's site.

(b) Fifty percent (50%) of the above drawn sample (subject to a minimum of 6 units) shall be sent to any of the approved /accredited laboratories for full bench test as per IS:15803:2008 and rest of the sample units shall be subjected to practical performance test as per IS:15803:2008 for the rated duration and the users comfort at the Rescue Station.

(c) The batch of supply for which all the test results of the samples (100%) are found satisfactory shall only be accepted. In case of unsatisfactory test result even of single sample, either at the laboratory or in the practical performance test, the entire batch of supply shall not be accepted for use.


(d) The cost of testing of SCSR as per IS:15803:2008 at any of the approved / accredited laboratories and transportation charges to the accredited laboratory shall be borne by the manufacturer / supplier.

13. Testing after issue at the belowground mines:

Every SCSR on roll of the mines shall be subjected to Leak Tightness Test at least once in a quarter by a competent person duly authorized by the Manager for the purpose, in a manner as prescribed by DGMS.

The bidder shall supply the Leak Testing Machine free of cost at a scale of one machine for every 200 SCSRs' or part thereof (**Total 89 numbers**), along with





test certificate from any Govt. Test House/ Manufacturer about the effectiveness of the Leak Testing machine.

Manufacturer / supplier shall replace free of cost the total number of SCSRs which were found unsatisfactory after above tests within two months from the date of failure

The leakage Testing Machine shall also be warranted for TEN YEARS and in case of breakdown / malfunctioning, the same shall be repaired/ replaced by the Supplier/Manufacturer of SCSR free of cost.

14. Functional Ability Testing :-

(a) One percent of total units of a particular make and type of SCSR under service shall be drawn randomly every year for tests subject to a minimum of one unit of each make and type for functional ability at any of the approved /accredited laboratories as per IS:15803:2008.

(b) In case of unsatisfactory test result(s), during the above functional ability test all SCSRs of the batch whose sample had failed shall be immediately withdrawn from the use.

(c) The cost of testing of SCSR as per IS:15803:2008 at any of the approved / accredited laboratories and transportation charges to the accredited laboratory shall be borne by the manufacturer / supplier

(d) You shall replace free of cost the entire batch of SCSRs which will be found unsatisfactory after above tests within two months from the date of failure. WCL will have the right to encash the PBG proportionately to recover the cost of rejected SCSR from the manufacturer / supplier in case of failure to replace them free of cost within two months

15. SUBMISSION OF BILLS:-Pre-receipted and stamped invoice for 100% for 80% value of each materials with taxes and duties and other charges shall be submitted in "QUADRUPLICATE" to the consignee along with following documents:

- a) Consignment note/Delivery Challan in original.
- b) Self attested copy of BIS license/DGMS approval/Manufacturer Test certificate required (if any)as per enclosed technical specification- Annexure-I
- c) Warranty/Guarantee certificate
- d) Pre-receipted and stamped Invoice.GST Compliant Invoice as per GST rule indicating all the details as required as per GST rule, Including HSN code, components of SGST/CGST/IGST (as applicable) etc, which shall enable WCL to avail ITC as per GST rule.
- e) Manufacturing Certificate from the manufacturer for each bill to the following effect:-
"Certified that the items supplied included in this bill/invoice are of own make have been actually manufactured in our works at. . . . (Address of the factory)."
- f)Price certificate
- g)Performance Bank Guarantee as per payment terms and performance Bank Guarantee clause

16.LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:- In the event of failure to execute the contract within the stipulated period mentioned in the order and in the event of breach of

any of the terms and conditions in the order WCL has the right :-

- a) To recover from successful tenderer, as agreed liquidated damages, a sum not less than 0.5% of the contract value for delay in execution of the contract beyond the delivery schedule (for this purpose part of a unit supplied will not be considered) as aforesaid for each week or part of a week during which the execution may be in arrears limited to 10 %. Where felt necessary the limit of 10% can be increased to 15% at the discretion of buyer
- b) To purchase from elsewhere, after due notice to the successful tenderer, on the account and at the risk of the defaulting supplier the stores not supplied or others of a similar description without cancelling the supply order in respect of consignment not yet due for supply or
- c) To cancel the supply order or a portion thereof, and if so desired, to purchase the store at the risk and cost of the supplier and also
- d) To extend the delivery period with or without imposition of Liquidated Damages as may be considered fit and proper. The penalty if imposed shall not be more than the agreed liquidated damages referred to clause (a) above.
- e) To encash any available Bank Guarantee / security deposit for recovery of the penalty.
- f) Whenever under the contract a sum of money is recoverable from and payable by the supplier, Western Coalfields Limited, shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating, in part or whole by deducting any sum or which at any time thereafter, may be due to the successful tenderer in this or any other contract, with Western Coalfields Limited or any of its Subsidiary Company. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:- If the execution of the contract/supply order is delayed beyond the period stipulated in the contract/supply order as a result of outbreak of hostilities, declaration of an embargo or blockade, or fire, flood, acts of nature or any other contingency beyond the supplier's control due to act of God then Coal India Limited or its subsidiary companies may allow such additional time by extending the delivery period, as it considers to be justified by the circumstances of the case and its decision shall be final. If and when additional time is granted by the Coal India Limited and its subsidiary companies, the contract/supply order shall be read and understood as if it had contained from its inception the delivery date as extended.

- a) The successful bidder will advise, in the event of his having to resort to this clause, by a registered letter duly certified by the local chamber of commerce or statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the causes of the delay, within fifteen days of the occurrence and cessation of such force majeure conditions. In the event of delay lasting out of force majeure, WCL will reserve the right to cancel the contract, and provisions governing termination of contract as stated in the bid documents will apply.
- b) For delay arising out of Force majeure, the bidder will not claim the extension in completion date for a period exceeding the period of delay attributable to the causes of force majeure and neither WCL nor the bidder shall be liable to pay extra cost provided it is mutually established that the force majeure conditions did actually exist.



In the event of failure of the supplier to deliver or dispatch within the stipulated date/period of the supply order or in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions mentioned in the supply order, Coal India Ltd. or its Subsidiary Companies have the right to purchase the stores from elsewhere after due notice to the defaulting supplier at the risk and cost of the defaulting supplier. In the event of failure of the supplier as detailed above, the cost as per risk purchase exercise may be recovered from the bills against any other supplies pending in the same Subsidiary Co. and also in any other Subsidiary Companies/CIL.

Risk purchase action may be initiated under any of the following conditions:

- i. When the supplier fails to deliver the materials even after the delivery period is extended on several occasions, on request from the supplier.
