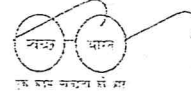

1. PRICE: The above prices are on F.O.R. destination basis inclusive of Packing, forwarding, freight & insurance and shall remain firm till the execution of order. Safe arrival of consignment at destination stores shall be your responsibility.
2. GST: Shall be payable extra as applicable. The present applicable rate of GST is @ 18%. Input tax credit on GST shall be availed by WCL as per GST rule. You shall submit GST compliant invoice enabling WCL to avail Input Tax Credit (ITC) under GST. In case of any failure on your account, the penalty including interest (if any) borne by WCL on ITC shall be recovered from you.
3. Other levies : Nil
4. Delivery Schedule: 25% of the total quantity for each item at Sl. No. 1-4 shall be supplied within one month, which shall be reckoned from the 7th day of order date. Thereafter at monthly rate of 10% of quantity allocated to each consignee for each item.
5. Transportation: By road on freight paid basis.
6. INSPECTION: Pre-dispatch inspection – The PVC Belting will be inspected by CMPDI at manufacturer's works before dispatch of the same to ascertain the conformity of the Belting to supply order specifications, relevant ISS, latest (including amendment), statutory regulations (DGMS) and type test certificates. Such inspections shall not, in case of any defect noticed later, entitle the supplier to plead that inspection has been done by the purchaser and absolve them of the obligation.

Pre-dispatch inspection including stage inspection of the ordered material shall be carried out by CMPDI. 

15. Liquidated Damages Clause:- In the event of failure to deliver the stores within the stipulated period mentioned in the order and in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions in the order WCL has the right:-

- a. To recover from successful tenderer, as agreed liquidated damages, a sum not less than 0.5% of the price of the store which successful tenderer has not been able to supply (for this purpose part of a unit supplied will not be considered) as aforesaid for each week or part of a week during which the delivery of such stores may be in arrears limited to 10%. Where felt necessary the limit of 10% can be increased to 15% at the discretion of buyer
- b. To purchase from elsewhere, after due notice to the successful tenderer, on the account and at the risk of the defaulting supplier the stores not supplied or others of a similar description without cancelling the supply order in respect of consignment not yet due for supply or
- c. To cancel the supply order or a portion thereof, and if so desired, to purchase the store at the risk and cost of the supplier and also
- d. To extend the delivery period with or without imposition of Liquidated Damages as may be considered fit and proper. The penalty if imposed shall not be more than the agreed liquidated damages referred to clause (a) above.
- e. To encash any available Bank Guarantee / security deposit for recovery of the penalty.
- f. Whenever under the contract a sum of money is recoverable from and payable by the supplier, Western Coalfields Limited, shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating, in part or whole by deducting any sum or which at any time thereafter, may be due to the successful tenderer in this or any other contract, with Western Coalfields Limited or any of its Subsidiary Company. Should this sum be not sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable, the successful tenderer shall pay to Western Coalfields Limited, on demand the remaining amount.





Such inspection shall not, in case of any defect noticed later, entitle the supplier to plead that inspection has been done by the purchaser and absolve them of the obligation.
ii-The inspector will conduct/witness the following tests on the samples drawn on the belting offered for inspection as per the sampling and testing clause of IS:3181-Latest (including amendment 2005) and as per the test methods specified in the standard.

ii- In case these services are lacking and also in the event of poor quality and unsatisfactory performance, WCL reserves the right to cancel/reduce the ordered quantity, if necessary.
