- 1. Price: The Prices are FIRM on FOR Destination basis inclusive of packing & forwarding charges, Freight and transit insurance upto destination. Safe arrival of the consignment at destination shall be your responsibility. Supply of Equipment will be made from BEML Ltd Mysore / KGF and supply of spares will be made from BEML Ltd, Chandrapur.
- 2. GST: GST shall be paid at actual against documentary evidence as applicable at the time of Dispatch within the stipulated delivery period. The current rate of GST applicable on equipment is 28%. Input Tax Credit benefit shall be availed by the consignee, for which you should submit GST Complaint Invoice. You have to comply with the terms and conditions of GST Act/ Rules such as issuance of Tax Invoices, ensure payment of GST and enabling mechanism to facilitate Input Tax credit by WCL. - 14. <u>Liquidated Damages clause and Risk Purchase clause:</u> In the event of failure to deliver or dispatch the stores within the stipulated date / period in accordance with the samples and/or specification mentioned in the supply order, and in event of breach of any terms and conditions mentioned in the supply order, Coal India Limited shall have the right,

Force Majeure Clause: If the execution of the contract/supply order is delayed beyond the period stipulated in the contract/supply order as a result of outbreak of hostilities, declaration of an embargo or blockade, or fire, flood, acts of nature or any other contingency beyond the supplier's control due to act of God then Coal India Limited or its subsidiary companies any allow such additional time by extending the delivery period, as it considers to be justified by the circumstances of the case and its decision shall be final. You will advise, in the event of having to resort to this clause by a registered letter duly certified by the local Chamber of Commerce or Statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the causes of the delay, within fifteen days of the occurrence and cessation of such Force Majeure conditions. For delay arising out of Force majeure, supplier will not claim extension in completion date for a period exceeding the period of delay attributed to the cause to the causes of Force Majeure and neither WCL nor the supplier shall be liable to pay extra costs provided it is mutually established that Force Majeure conditions did actually exist.

The Consumables for operation shall not include Diesel/ Fuel, Oils, Lubricants (POL) and TYRES.

- (I) Following items shall be supplied, along with each Equipment:-
- Spare Parts and Consumables, required for initial 12 Months.
- b. First fill of all Oils, Grease and Lubricants needed for test and commissioning of each equipment.
- c. A comprehensive tool kit, which shall include necessary special tools required for erection, commissioning and for the maintenance & repair of the Equipment.

Special Tools for maintenance shall include Accumulator charging kit (if Accumulator is provided), Suspension/ Nitrogen charging kit & Cartridge filter opening tool etc.

(II) Spare Parts & Consumables for 3 years (36 months) operation, out of total 4 years (48 months), in accordance with your recommendations shall be delivered periodically (in minimum three lots, Annually in consultation with the user project), throughout the balance period of 3 years (thirty six Months), of the total Guaranteed period of 4 years (forty eight months) from the accepted date of commissioning.

A.3 Information and Drawings

You shall provide following manuals / documents with EACH Equipment, before commissioning:-

a. One set of suitably illustrated Operating, Repair and Maintenance Instructions for all the equipment, written in the English language, substantially bound in book form, as well as soft copy (in Pen drive / CD) with Each Equipment.

b. One set of suitably illustrated, detailed Spares Parts Manuals covering all plant, Equipment and accessories substantially bound in book form; as well as soft copy (in pen drive/ CD), with Each Equipment. ONE Set of Manuals (Hard & soft copies) shall be supplied to the office of GM(Exc)HOD, Excavation deptt WCL(HQ) Nagpur, at the time of supply.

You shall also submit the data identified in the specifications for each item of Equipment. In addition to the Equipment drawings, you shall supply detailed drawings illustrating erection/ assembly site, foundation for such items as drive motors, switch installations etc (where appropriate) and accommodation requirements (if any).
