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NOTICE FOR E- AUCTION BIDDERS (BY RAIL) FOR SUBMISSION OF SECURITY TOWARDS DMF DUES

The successful bidders in e-Auction (Special Forward e- Auction/Spl Spot e- Auction & Spot e- Auction) are requested to ensure submission of Security towards DMF dues in addition to payment of Coal value towards commercial clearance so that consenting as well as seeking allotment (Indents) of their secured rakes can be made within 45 days of the validity from the date of consent as per the provisions of the respective schemes.

In case of **Special Forward e- Auction for Power**, non submission of Security towards DMF dues in addition to payment of Coal value for commercial clearance of the rakes allocated shall lead to consent/movement of rakes lying next below in bid seniority (for which DMF security is received). It is clarified that WCL after commercial clearance, is required to send consent/offer to Rlys for the allocated rakes by the last date of the previous month. Therefore, Security for DMF dues if any by all the bidders is necessarily required to be submitted within validity period i.e 45 days from the date of consent (last date of the previous month of offer) for seeking allotment (Indent) of their rakes, failing which such rakes shall lapse with forfeiture of EMD.

In case of **Special Spot e- Auction**, non submission of Security towards DMF dues in addition to payment of Coal value for commercial clearance of consented rakes for seeking allotment(Indent) within the validity period i,e 45 days from the date of consent/offer, movement of rakes lying next below in bid seniority (for which DMF security is received) shall be made. However, security for DMF dues if any, by all the bidders is necessarily required to be submitted before the stipulated period of seeking allotment as per the scheme i,e 45 days from the date of consent/offer, failing which such consented rakes shall lapse with forfeiture of EMD.

In case of **Spot e-auction**, non submission of Security towards DMF dues in addition to payment of Coal value for the rakes secured shall lead to consenting/movement of rakes lying next below in bid seniority (for which DMF security is received). It is clarified that WCL could not send consent/offer for some of the rakes in Spot Auction conducted on 8.12.2017 for want of DMF Security, although in normal course consent would have been sent to Rlys latest by the end of the month of Dec 16 itself. Therefore, DMF Security by all the bidders in any case is necessarily required to be submitted before 13.2.2017 i.e 45 days from 31.12.2016 for consenting and seeking allotment (Indent) of their rakes, failing which such rakes shall lapse with forfeiture of EMD.
