Sub. : Preventing Pilferage of Coal

Chief Vigilance Officer, WCL, has made certain recommendations to strengthen the system for preventing pilferage of coal from mines.

1. Road sale trucks should not be allowed to stay in the night in the mine premises. Their entry and exit should be regulated accordingly.
2. As per NIT, only tippers should be used for transporting of coal.
3. 'First come - first served' should be observed in case of loading of road sale trucks.
4. System of tare weight, gross weight etc. should be same at loading and unloading point.
5. The weighbridge should be so maintained that weighbridge officials may clearly see the vehicles and other activities on the weighbridge platform to avoid manipulation. No films etc. are put on glass windows of the weighbridge office, hindering the transparency.
6. Rotation of sensitive staff i.e. Weighbridge clerk, Security personnel should be periodically effected to avoid vested interest and pilferage of coal.

You are requested to strictly follow these recommendations of CVO, WCL to avoid any pilferage of coal. A system for monitoring should also be evolved, if not already exists in the mines. Necessary confirmation about action taken may be intimated at the earliest.
